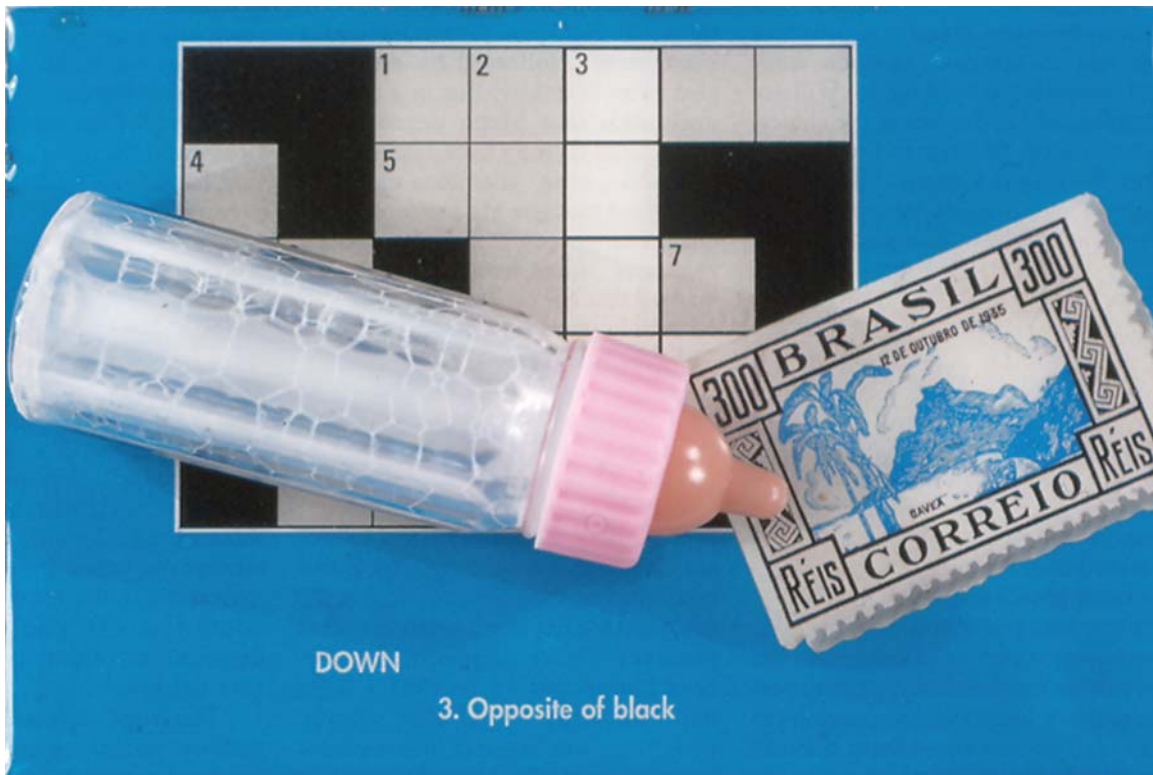

This year, the Visual and Performing Arts department will be saying farewell to two long-time faculty members as they ready for retirement: Louis Cicotello (3-D) and Lin Fife (Fiber). Please join us at the opening reception as we thank them and celebrate their years of service to UCCS.

Lin Fife first began teaching at UCCS in 1974 where she initiated the studio programs in Fiber, Papermaking and Artists' Books as well as numerous travel-study courses. Lin's work has been exhibited at the international Book Arts Exhibition, Marseille, France; Tucson Museum of Art, Tucson, AZ; Studio Gallery, Riverdale, MD; the International Gallery, San Diego, CA; and Miriam Perlman Gallery, Chicago, IL.

Louis Cicotello has been a faculty member at UCCS since 1984. His work has been exhibited at the Art Research Center, Kansas City, MO; Paris Gibson Square Museum of Art, Great Falls, MT; Sangre De Cristo Art Center, Pueblo, CO; Joslyn Museum, Omaha, NE; and the Colorado Springs Fine Arts Center, Colorado Springs, CO. He has co-authored a number of books on art and theory in addition to designing sets for UCCS's Theatreworks and the Colorado Springs Fine Arts Center.
